Christmas Collection

Due to COVID-19, we will not be able to serve at Trinity Episcopal Church on Christmas Eve. There is too much risk associated in it.

We still want to reach out to our community. Wayne Nursing and Continuous Care Home is a 60 bed facility. LUMC has several residents connected to church and family members there. This year will be very difficult and different for the residents and staff of the Care Home. If things continue as they are, very few, if any, visitors will be allowed in.

We would like to redirect our collection of items towards the nursing home. Following is a list of items they could use, enjoy, or need. We will have drop off boxes at church. All items will need to be in before Christmas because they will have to quarantine them for so many days before distributing. Please let us know if you would like to help. This would be similar to the care bags we gather for each year, and the past few years we have distributed over 100 bags on Christmas Eve.

Personal or travel sized - shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, hand lotion, etc

Chapstick, individual packages of tissues, liquid hand soap

Individual snack cakes, small cans of pop or juice

Items such as socks

Hats and wallets for men

Scarves for women

Even blankets would be appreciated

Not allowed: powders of any type, aerosol cans of any type, individual hand sanitizer
